## Two Narcotics Warrants Served

MONROE – On Tuesday, January 11, 2011 at 7:22 am, the Monroe Police Department ProAct and Special Emergency Response (SERT) Teams served search warrants on two residences located in the 700 block of Maple St and the 18600 block of Blueberry Lane in Monroe. The search warrants were obtained as part of an on-going heroin distribution investigation. During the search of the residences, officers seized heroin, marijuana, prescription pills, cash, packaging materials and drug paraphernalia. Two motorcycles were also seized. A total of four males (two from each residence) were taken into custody.

Jacob Nieves, age 23 of Monroe was charged with Possession with Intent to Distribute/Deliver and Obstruction-Resisting an Officer. Dustin Nieves, age 24 and Daniel Krempf, age 23 of Monroe were charged with Possession with Intent to Distribute/Deliver. All three were taken to the Snohomish County jail for booking. An additional arrest of a 22-year-old male from Snohomish was made on a Department of Corrections Violation. While investigators were at the scene, two additional males stopped by to make purchases. They were placed under arrest and charges will be forwarded to the prosecutor.
